Mystery shrouds death of a person in mango orchard in UP

Varanasi : On Saturday, the body of a middle-aged man was found in a semi-nude state in a mango orchard located in Baikunthpur village Dayalpur Mauza of Phulpur police station area. As soon as the information was received, DCP Gomti Zone Manish Shandilya, ACP Pidra, Phulpur police station in-charge also reached the spot. After investigation and identification etc., the officers took the body into custody and sent it for post-mortem. When the villagers of Dayalipur Mauza of Baikunthpur village went out to the fields in the morning, Ravi Shankar Patel (51), a middle-aged man of the village, was found dead in a field located in a mango orchard. Villagers were stunned to see the half-naked body. As soon as the information about the body was received, a crowd of villagers gathered in the garden. Police officers who reached on the information called the forensic team and took action to collect evidence. The family members told during interrogation that

Ravi Shankar used to operate power loom while living in Mumbai. He had come to the village from Mumbai to attend the wedding of his elder brother Lalji's daughter. After his niece's marriage, Ravi Shankar was staying at home instead of going to Mumbai. Family members told that whenever Ravi Shankar Patel came home from

Mumbai, he used to stay in the shed and garden outside the house. Ravi Shankar has two sons. Ravi Shankar's elder son Arun Patel eloped with a girl from the village on May 9. The girl's father has filed an FIR against Ravi Shankar, his wife and son. According to the police investigation, apparently Ravi Shankar died under suspicious circumstances.

Rajkot: Passenger passage canopy breaks at Hirasar airport; major accident averted

Rajkot : The canopy built for passengers at the Greenfield International Airport in Hirasar, Rajkot, broke on Saturday morning. Rajkot has been receiving heavy rains with strong winds for the last two days. It was told that the canopy broke due to this. A major accident was averted as there were no passengers under the canopy. Rajkot Hirasar Airport Director Digant Bahora said that water had accumulated on the canopy due to rain, due to which it broke. The accident took place outside the temporary terminal. No one was injured in the incident. According to the information, it has been raining with strong winds in Rajkot since Friday. The rain continued on Saturday morning as well. It was also raining between 11 a.m. and 11.30 a.m.

On the other hand, questions are being raised about the quality of the canopy, etc., regarding its breaking. Greenfield Airport was inaugurated by PM Modi.Prime Minister Narendra Modi inaugurated an international airport near Rajkot city in Gujarat on July 27, 2023. It is the first greenfield airport in the state and has been built at a cost of Rs 1,405 crore. The airport campus located at Hirasar village, about 30 km from Rajkot, is spread over an area of 1,025.50 hectares (2,534 acres), out of which the Airports Authority of India has built the airport in an area of 1,500 acres. PM Modi laid the foundation stone for this international airport in Hirasar village near Rajkot city in October 2017.

Second session of the 16th Legislative Assembly from July 3, strong security arrangements

Jaipur, : The second session of the 16th Rajasthan Legislative Assembly will begin on Wednesday, July 3. The Legislative Assembly Secretariat has made all the necessary arrangements regarding the session. Special security arrangements have been made for the assembly during the session. Speaker Vasudev Devnani reviewed the arrangements to be made related to the session. Principal Secretary Mahavir

Prasad Sharma discussed with the departmental officials for the work to be done by various departments during the Legislative Assembly session. The progress report of the work is being submitted to the Legislative Assembly by the officials of various departments. Only the entry card with photo will be valid during the Legislative Assembly session. Officers and employees will be able to enter the Legislative Assembly only with the

photo QR code entry card. The flag barrier will open only after scanning the QR code and visitors will be able to enter the Legislative Assembly. The same procedure will have to be followed to go out of the Legislative Assembly building. Mobile phones cannot be used in the Legislative Assembly House. The use of mobile phones has been prohibited in the House. Only those vehicles will be

allowed to enter the Vidhan Sabha Bhawan premises which have the sessional vehicle entry pass of the second session. The movement of the vehicles of officers and employees will be through Gate No. 1 North Eastern gate and parking will be done on the ground floor of the eastern gate. The entry of journalists' vehicles will also be done through Gate No. 1 and parking will be done at the place made in the eastern and southern corner.

Municipal Corporation team seized 1.8 quintal polythene, recovered fine of Rs. 20k

Moradabad, : As part of the campaign being run by the Municipal Corporation team on Saturday against banned polythene, they raided various shops in Budh Bazaar of Sadar Kotwali area and seized 1.80 quintals of banned polythene found there. Besides, a fine of Rs 20 thousand has also been collected from some traders on the spot. Yesterday, 25 quintals of polythene was seized in the metropolis. Chief Assessment Officer Aarti Singh said that on the instructions of the Municipal Commissioner, a campaign is being run against banned polythene. She informed that today 1.80 quintals of banned polythene has been seized. Apart from this, a fine of twenty thousand rupees has also been collected. Apart from Chief Assessing Officer Aarti Singh, RI Deepak Singh, Keshav Vishnoi, Umesh Tomar, the corporation's team and enforcement team were present during the action.

Nine arrested in GU marksheet scam

Guwahati, : Nine accused of the Guwahati University marksheet scam have been arrested in a joint operation by Barpeta Road Police and CID. It is noteworthy that marks were illegally increased in the marksheets of students by taking bribes. Chief Minister Dr. Himanta Biswa Sarma took the issue seriously in Barpeta and entrusted the CID with the task of investigating it. He said that Barpeta Police and CID are jointly investigating the matter. It is known that this scam came to light when the officials of Ganeshlal Choudhary College (GLC College) located on Barpeta Road revealed the discrepancy in the marks of Azizul Haque, a sixth year undergraduate student. A case was immediately registered at

the Barpeta Road police station, although the Barpeta police were accused of covering it up. Because the accused was released from custody. After the issue was raised by the local media, the Chief Minister ordered an investigation into the matter. The investigation has revealed the involvement of several employees of the university and colleges. Those arrested include Krishnan Krishnamurthy, employed at Guwahati University, and Sivatosh Mahato, a junior computer assistant at Dhubri Law College. The arrests were made in a joint raid by the Barpeta and Dhubri police. The nine accused include Azizul Haque, Krishnan Krishnamurthy (Gauhati University employee), Ismail Hussain (Kalgachhia), Alamgir

Khan (Amguri, Kalgachhia), Moinul Haque (Bardanga, Kalgachhia), Hameez Uddin (Nagaon), Aminul Islam (librarian, Langla College), Sivatosh Mahato (junior computer assistant, Dhubri Law College) and Abul Bakar (Langla, Kalgachhia). A case has been registered against the accused under several sections of the law. More arrests are likely. However, the police are refraining from saying anything in this case.

Banners and posters put up on streets of Ranchi in support after release of Hemant Soren

Ranchi : JMM workers are excited after the release of former Chief Minister of the state Hemant Soren from jail. They are celebrating his arrival. His posters started appearing on the streets of Ranchi after he got bail from the court. Banners and posters were seen in his support on the streets of the capital Ranchi on Saturday. It is noteworthy that on the night of January 31, the ED arrested Hemant Soren on charges of land scam. Since then he was lodged in Birsa Munda Central Jail. About five months later, on

June 28, the Jharkhand High Court granted him bail. After this he was released from jail. Reacting to the whole matter, CPI General Secretary D Raja said that this decision of the court is welcome. The central government is using central agencies to target opposition parties. His release will further strengthen the India alliance. He said that justice will prevail, truth will prevail. JMM MP Mahua Manjhi said on Saturday that Hemant Soren is a very popular leader in Jharkhand. Despite his absence in the Lok Sabha

elections, the public supported us. There is a lot of enthusiasm after his release from jail. BJP's conspiracy to garner votes by arresting popular leader Hemant Soren has failed. Leader of Opposition in Lok Sabha Rahul Gandhi has also expressed happiness over his release. He had said on social media last Friday that the arrest of former Jharkhand Chief Minister Hemant Soren was done out of revenge and political malice. We welcome the decision of the High Court to grant him bail.

Decomposed body of a woman recovered in Bihali

Sonitpur (Assam) : A semi-decomposed body was recovered near the railway line in Milanpur village of Bargang in Bihali. The recovered body has been identified as Leoni Induwar (50). Locals said that the woman was a resident of Bargang. It is known that the woman was missing since June 22.
